The minutes of the March 15 meeting were approved by acclamation.





Jeff Morris
Introduction to Paphiopedilum

Jeff Morris, President of the Charlottesville Orchid Society, will be the speaker for our May 10th meeting. His presentation will be on the Introduction to Paphiopedilums - Species and Hybrids.

"Over 35 years ago I purchased a phalaenopsis for a gift to give to a relative. Silly me, at the time I decided that I could grow this strange plant and purchased a seedling for myself. This has led to an addiction to orchids that involved doubling my collection every 6 months for the first several years. Currently, I grow in excess of 3500 orchids in 3500 sq ft. of greenhouse space. Early on I favored paphiopedilums and vandas. These are still among my favorites, but I now grow over 100 genera. I am currently the president of the Charlottesville Orchid Society and have served 5 terms as President over the years. I have been fortunate enough to receive over 45 AOS awards over the years, most of them cultural. And if this wasn't enough to classify me as a true orchid nut, I decided to set up a small lab and start flasking my own seedlings during the pandemic.


