





Jon Ibasco: "Here is my Carol Shores Cattleya. It has 11 new growths forming and will hopefully bloom in 2025. I've been giving it a very light dose of Fish Superthrive every other watering with a top dressing of Nutricote 18-6-8 and once a month MSU 13-3-15. It gets soaked with rainwater once a week and will be gradually increasing the intervals as spring approaches. I have it potted in power orchiata mixed with charcoal and perlite and I also give it high humidity (75-95%), bright indirect light, and constant air circulation. Happy growing y'all.





The South Carolina Orchid Society would like to cordially invite your organization to exhibit at our upcoming show on April 26th-28th, 2024. Our show is held in our Society's home at the Garden Council of Greater Columbia Building at 1605 Park Circle, Columbia SC 29201. The building is located at the corners of Blossom and Pickens Streets in downtown Columbia- very near the USC main campus.

We will furnish black cloth back drops and electrical access for all who exhibit. We do recommend lighting for all exhibitors. This is a DRY show- so no fountains or water features this year.

We have the following exhibit spaces/table sizes available for your consideration:

- Floor exhibits can be 25 s/ft (5' X 5') or 50 s/ft (5' X 10')
- We have 6' tables available as well as a limited amount of "card tables"- 4' x 4' approx...

Schedule of events:

- Exhibit set up will be on Thursday April 25th from 9 AM until 4:30 PM.
- Plant registration will be on Thursday, April 25th from 9:30 AM.
 - We ask that you complete pre-registration for your plants in advance and send those documents to us so we all have ample time to complete the project.
- AOS Judging will begin on Friday, April 26th at 9 AM and will continue until complete.
 - o The show will open on Friday, April 26th at 1 PM and close at 6 PM.
 - o The show will run on Saturday, April 27th from 11 AM until 6 PM.
 - o The show will run on Sunday, April 28th from 11 AM until 4 PM.
- Takedown will begin on Sunday, April 28th no earlier than 3:45 PM.

All orchid shows are very important for public awareness and involvement, sharing of information and building the orchid growing community in our area, and we all want to continue to see our organizations thrive and grow in the years ahead. We hope that your society will plan to participate and- as always- the South Carolina Orchid Society does reciprocate with attending societies by participating in your shows as well!
